These sessions will be run by experienced teachers or consultants who have a proven track record. A behaviour management specialist and experienced SEND Co-ordinator will help them to establish robust behaviour management techniques and strategies around supporting key groups of children. There will be time to reflect on their learning environments and be supported with practical ways to enhance children's learning. There will also be sessions around managing their time, working with TA's and developing a work life balance. Jill Stolberg (Church School Distinctiveness Advisor) will work with them to deepen their knowledge around what working in a Church school means. She will support them to develop practical and informative ways to teach RE and lead Collective Worship.
