Day One

Key Questions: What is a middle leader? What skills do I need to do the job well? How do I make a start and what do I need to know?

We will explore the features of middle leadership, identify preferred influencing strategies, understand accountabilities, learn and use practical leadership skills and discover how to effectively audit.

Day Two

Key Questions: How do I work out where I want to get to? How do I create a vision that inspires? How do I know what is good practice? How do I build my support network?

We will explore a framework for self-directed change, create a compelling vision for change, conduct a gap analysis for an area of school improvement and learn how to coach others and share ownership.

Day Three

Key Questions: How do I create a strategic plan? How do I achieve outcomes that have impact? How do I manage the demands of external stakeholders? How do I manage difficult people?

We will create a strategic plan with milestones, develop skills to motivate others, understand how to mange change effectively and how to have difficult conversations. Consider the expectations Ofsted has for middle leaders.

Day Four

Key Questions: How do I present myself to others? How do I demonstrate the impact of my leadership? How do I grow as a leader?

We will consider how to present the impact of your leadership to others, prepare and give a brief presentation to the group, critique and give feedback to others, celebrate success and identify key learning and plan for next steps.
