

Settings to optimise your Zoom recordings


You'll need the Zoom application set up on your device and access to your account.

To record a video on zoom, here's a video tutorial on the basics.

To get to your **settings on Zoom**: click on the cog wheel icon on the right hand corner or click your profile picture and find settings from the drop down options.





1. Video Settings


Make sure you tick the following:

• Enable HD

Optional:

- Touch up my appearance
 This feature retouches the camera feed with a soft focus. You can move the slider to adjust the effect
- Adjust for low light
 This feature helps to brighten dark environments. You can choose between auto and manual

Zoom remembers your preference and uses it the next time you start or join a meeting on your computer.






2. Recording Settings

Make sure you tick the following:

- Optimize for 3rd Party Video Editor
- Record a separate audio file for each participant (This is useful if multiple people featured in video. This is necessary too, if someone is going to edit your recording.)

The location of your recorded files are stated at the top of the window.





3. Home Settings

Here are ways to make sure that you are seen and heard well in your meetings:

As well as the tips in the visual on the right;

- Make use of lamps
- Use headphones that have a built in mic
- Lift camera to eye line
