Newly Qualified Teachers

This series of sessions through the year will be the equivalent of four full days (some days maybe split into two half days) of quality CPD for NQTs.

As the 2019/20 cohort missed out on two of their days, we will open these sessions to them free of charge.

The cost for 20/21 cohort is £180

Each session will cover a variety of topics to enable NQTs to further develop their pedagogical knowledge and practical skills around teaching and learning.

These sessions will be run by experienced teachers or consultants who have a proven track record. A behaviour management specialist and experienced SEND Co-ordinator will help them to establish robust behaviour management techniques and strategies around supporting key groups of children. There will be time to reflect on their learning environments and be supported with practical ways to enhance children's learning. There will also be sessions around managing their time, working with TAs and developing a work/life balance. Jill Stolberg will work with them to deepen their knowledge around what working in a Church school means. She will support them to develop practical and informative ways to teach RE.

Recently Qualified Teachers

This series of sessions through the year will be the equivalent of four full days (some days may be split into two half days).

The cost for 20/21 cohort is £180

Four full days especially designed for teachers in their second or third year of teaching. The programme has five main principles which focus on deepening learning, role modelling, improving engagement and challenge in order to make the biggest impact on progress.

Drawing upon current research, this reflective course will provide the participants with practical skills to deepen understanding of different pedagogical approaches, including questioning, improving knowledge around the effective use of data to accelerate progress and develop their effective use of teaching assistants.

One day will be a school-based day where participants will have the opportunity to observe and talk to excellent teachers in their own classrooms.

The programme is designed and run by Mark Carr, the Deputy Head at Holly Hill Church School.

Subject Leader Training:

Building Blocks to Leadership

This series of sessions through the year will be the equivalent of four full days (some days may be split into two half days).

The cost for 20/21 cohort is £220 (dependent on numbers)

A leadership programme for teachers new to subject leadership.

The sessions will work through and explore the skills needed for successful subject leadership, especially with the demands of the current Ofsted framework. They will look at developing a vision, a strategic plan, look at how to work with and motivate others alongside lots more practical advice and guidance.

The programme is designed and led by Forward Leadership who work with leaders across the Midlands.
